The Alcohol and Other Drug Program is for any youth who abuses alcohol and/or other drugs, has a family member who abuses alcohol and/or other drugs, or is referred by the school or juvenile court for an alcohol and/or drug offence. A formal referral is not necessary and family, friends, churches, or agencies may refer anyone 7-17 into the program. Sliding fee scale, co-pays range from \$5 and up. Medicaid and some insurances accept for payment.
